A level Results Day will take place on Tuesday 10th August.

GCSE Results day will take place on Thursday 12th August 2021.

For students in Year 11, the results day on 12th August is also the enrolment day for the SHFGS Sixth Form. Students will need to log on to the SHFGS Admissions+ site to complete the enrolment process.

As per last year, results days will not be face to face in school and results will be posted on students' Go 4 Schools accounts from 8.30am on the respective days for Years' 13 and 11.
