Elevate Education Webinar: Re-Imagining University and Future Careers

I am excited to share that Elevate have added a **Parent Webinar** to their schedule for next week.

Next **Tuesday 30th March** Elevate will be teaming up with **London Interdisciplinary School** (<https://www.londoninterdisciplinarityschool.org>, the UK's newest university, to discuss the new and exciting university options that students will have from 2021).

London Interdisciplinary School (LIS) are looking to revolutionise the university experience by:

- **Curriculum based on solving real world problems:** The teaching for each term is based around solving real world problems, for real world organisations, that impact real people. Working with the Met Police to address knife crime in London, helping the WHO beat Malaria in sub-Saharan Africa.
- **Interdisciplinary learning:** Problems like those described above are complex and multi-faceted, and not easily solved by one "discipline" of knowledge, which is why the curriculum at LIS is interdisciplinary, drawing upon science, maths, social sciences, arts and the humanities.
- **Real-world job exposure:** Students' exposure to problem solving isn't just theoretical. LIS secures paid internships with students at some of the UK's leading firms and non-profits. From solving urban regeneration problems with London's largest engineering firm, to tackling food waste problems at London's restaurants with a leading NGO. Every student graduates from LIS with a paid work placement to put on their CV, increasing their opportunities when they enter the job market.

There is an exciting panel of speakers for the evening, including Ed Fidoe (Founder and Founder of School 21), Professor Carl Gombich (Head of Teaching and formerly Professor of Interdisciplinary Learning at UCL), as well as students and some of LIS' corporate partners for 2021.
